Thank you for your interest in the 15th national psychology congress!

How you read in the invitation, there is the possibility to either give a lecture or exhibit a poster. Just **one activity** is possible per person.

This document lists the most important information for the **lecture**.

Students deciding for the lecture get the opportunity to present their Bachelor or Master thesis in front of an audience that is interested in the psychological field.

- You get a slot of **30 minutes**. 20 minutes are planned for the lecture and the remaining 10 minutes should be used for discussion or the answering of questions.
- You can present a **completed project** or a **work in progress**.
- Your work and poster have to thematically fit into the field of psychology. Other than that, there are no limitation.

Optimally, your lecture has a future-oriented focus and embeds the results in the current research field and connects them with the latest research development.

- For your lecture we provide a beamer and flipchart, which you gladly can use.
- First of all, we need an **abstract** for your lecture from you, where you give important information about your hypothesis, results etc. It should contain ca. 150 words and has to be written in English. Please send us your abstract as soon as possible after your registration.
- Please attach a **photo** of you (passport size).

The participation is voluntary and students who only give a lecture don't have to pay a fee. If you want to participate in the whole congress, we ask you to pay a reduced admission price. Accommodation and meals are included in the price.
